- 3) The Mingler - Parents will often stay at the church while the youth are rehearsing. This would be the perfect time to mingle & visit with these parents. Out of the few registration forms we have already received, one family noted they do not attend church. What a perfect opportunity to get to know these people & invite them to Crosspoint!
- 4) Prayer Warriors - Most importantly we need people to pray! Pray for the leaders & the guest speakers as we present the Gospel to the youth & their families.
