#### **Words of Wisdom from Tim Challies...**

"Here is one thing I learned from my parents: Nothing can take the place of simply living as a Christian in view of my children. No amount of formal theological training, church attendance, or family devotions will make up for a general apathy about the things of the Lord. I can catechize my children all day and every day, but if I have no joy and no delight in the Lord, and if I am not living out my faith, my children will see it and know it...For all the good things my parents did for me, I believe that the most important was simply living as Christians before me. I don't think anything shaped or challenged me more than that."
