Then, one day you receive a letter from a fellow Christian that encourages you to persevere in your faith. You realize, gratefully, that you're not alone. The Voice of the Martyrs (VOM) has received numerous testimonies from former prisoners stating how much the letters encouraged them and served as a witness to prison guards. You can be that fellow Christian who encourages prisoners.” VOM's Prisoner Letter-Writing Stationery has been ordered and should arrive next week. You can simply use the stationery to write encouraging notes to Christian prisoners and their families. We will send the letters to VOM and they will distribute the letters within the 68 countries they serve.
