- 6) Visit the members of the congregation according to their needs.
- 7) Engage in hospitality and family visitation.
- 8) Exercise discipline in the congregation.
- 9) Actively promote, as a way of life, the work of evangelism and missions.
- 10) Finally, insure that everything is done decently and in order for His glory.
