John MacArthur recently preached a sermon titled, **How God Restrains Evil In Society**. In the near future, CD's of this sermon will be made available for distribution to our local civil authorities. Through this distribution, it is Crosspoint's desire to encourage these individuals in this noble, exalted calling of God. **The sermon DVD will be shown this Wednesday evening at 7pm.** Following is an excerpt from this sermon...

“Every person is born in sin. Sin nature is passed down from its parents. It goes all the way back to Adam and Eve. When Adam and Eve fell, their disposition changed. And then everything that's come from Adam and Eve, every human that's ever been born in the history of the world, has been born a sinner, passed down from the original parents. You want proof? Everybody dies. Salvation of God makes new hearts. The power of God then comes from the inside, overpowering that corruption. Not that we're perfect, but we have new desires, new longings, new aspirations, new hopes, and new direction. The church then offers the ultimate restraint, a transformed heart. The work of God in salvation is the great restraining work.”
