I know you spend so much of your time dealing with bad, but it's the fact that you deal with the bad that produces the good for everybody else. We understand that. It's a noble, noble thing you do. You are a minister of God for good; a minister of God, an avenger; an avenger who brings wrath on the one who practices evil. It's what you do. But you are a minister of God. Why? God ordained government and God delegated the authority to execute that government through you. There are only two professions in the Bible that are called ministers of God: mine and yours. That's it. What a noble, exalted calling!
