## New Bible Studies...

Join us Wednesday evenings at 7pm as we embark on a 6 week study, **Calvinism and the Christian Life** by Ian Hamilton. It is impossible to encounter God's majestic grace & not be powerfully, deeply, & permanently changed. John Calvin knew this. In this series, Pastor Ian Hamilton demonstrates that Calvinism is the overflow of a life captivated by the gospel of Jesus Christ. This theology is not simply academic. It is vital God-centered Christianity with important implications for our daily lives. Pastor Hamilton shows us a world where the triune God is the center of everything & where the grace of Jesus Christ shapes life in its length & breadth.

The men will be meeting monthly as they work their way through the book, **The Master's Plan for the Church** by John MacArthur. Dr. MacArthur notes that "it is absolutely essential for a church to perceive itself as an institution for the Glory of God, and to do that, the local church must adhere unfalteringly to biblical leadership principles. Christ never intended church leadership to be earned by seniority, purchased with money, or inherited through family ties. Not only is this book pertinent for pastors and elders, but for anyone who wants the church to be what God intended it to be."
