Our May Hymn of the Month is Take My Life and Let It Be, which was written by Frances Havergal in 1874. Although written more than one hundred years ago, Ms. Havergal's words are still relevant for today because Christ's call for complete devotion of hands, feet, voice, mind, emotions, and livelihood remains unchanged.
