This morning our Call to Worship is from Psalm 150. In the Treasury of David, Charles H. Spurgeon had this to say about the psalm:

We have now reached the last summit of the mountain-chain of Psalms. It rises high into the clear azure, and its brow is bathed in the sunlight of the eternal world of worship, it is a rapture. The poet-prophet is full of inspiration and enthusiasm. He stays not to argue, to teach, to explain; but cries with burning words, "Praise him, Praise him, Praise the LORD!"...There is nothing little about God, and there is nothing great apart from him. If we were always careful to make our worship fit and appropriate for our great Lord, how much better should we sing! How much more reverently should we adore! Such excellent deeds should have excellent praise.
